ISGPB-RN Sawhney Memorial Award (RNSMA)

Eligibility criteria

- A nominee should be Citizen of India and have minimum 5-years life member of the ISGPB
- Age: not more than 60 years (as on last date of application)
- At least 02 publications (Research paper /review) in Indian Journal of Genetics and Plant Breeding is compulsory for consideration for nomination.
- Should have proven record of original and meritorious research works in Crop improvement and associated fields with focus on *Resistance to biotic and abiotic stresses*.
- Publications and products, i.e. varieties/genetic stocks specific to <u>Resistance to biotic and abiotic stresses</u> will be considered.
- Any members who were awarded any ISGPB award in previous three years will not be eligible to apply.

Award Administration

- 1. ISGPB- RN Sawhney Memorial Award is biennial in nature and being sponsored from the generous donation by the family of Late Dr RN Sawhney.
- 2. This award consists of a plaque, citation, certificate and a cash prize of Rs 25,000/-.
- 3. Minimum of three applications are required for considering this award in particular cycle.
- 4. All the applications will be screened at two levels, first by screening committee and then by the Award committee constituted by the EC.
- 5. **Minimum 55 marks** are required for qualifying for the Award.
- 6. The recommendations of the Award Committee will be considered by the Executive Council for final decision and the deliberations relating to final selection will not be made public. In all matters relating to Award, no correspondence will be entertained.
- 7. The award will be presented either during the Annual General Body Meeting of the Society or notified separately.

Application Guidelines

- 1. Before applying, read the eligibility and score guidelines carefully.
- 2. A nominee can apply Fellowship and/or any of the award in a year.
- 3. Current members of ISGPB Executive Council (2023-24) are not eligible to apply.
- 4. Please use prescribed application form only. Any other format will not be considered.
- 5. Claim made in application form without proof will not be entertained and no marks will be given for the claim. For technology claim, please attach proper document in the form of gazette notification, publication in the peer reviewed journal as recommended by the recognized authority. Your name and role should be clearly indicated in the claim attached, otherwise no marks will be granted. Claim made in one section cannot be repeated under another section as a proof. No marks will be granted if any item repeated in another section.
- 6. Application form should be numbered starting from first page and page numbers should be continued on the proofs as well.
- 7. All the proofs should be attached with proper page numbering. For marking the score in the application form, page number of proofs for respective claims should be entered accordingly in the form so that the reviewing committee members can easily track the concerned proof of the claim.
- 8. **Last date for submission of the application form is December 15, 2023**. The duly signed complete application form along with proofs in a single pdf file should be mailed to the Secretary, ISGPB at email ID: secretaryisgpb@gmail.com on or before <u>December 15, 2023</u>. No updates/reprints/ additional information shall be considered after the closing date. The applicant must also send one hard copy of the application with supporting document to above mentioned address. The hard copy can be submitted to office of the society personally or through post.

- 1. Nomination of candidate should be proposed by **two ISGPB Fellows** excluding the present Executive committee members.

30 best research or review papers based on the work carried in crop improvement and related fields specific to Resistance to abiotic/biotic stresses excluding varietal notification will be considered.

- 1. Research or review papers will be assigned score as per latest NAAS scoring of journals, and the Journal ID should be mentioned in the column provided in the proforma against each publication.
- 2. For Non- NAAS rated journal having Thomson Reuters Impact Factor (IF) journals, Score = 6.0+ IF with capping on 20.00 should be used.
- 3. For Non- NAAS rated journal with no IF, 1.0 mark will be allocated to each paper.
- 4. Multiple authorship: First author and corresponding author will get full marks in a publication and rest of the authors 75% marks.
- 5. The total sum of NAAS Score of all the 30 publications will be multiplied by a factor of **0.1** with maximum cap of 30 marks.

B. Publications in the Indian Journal of Genetics & Plant Breeding

Maximum 05 publications will be considered EXCLUDING the papers mentioned in section A.

- 1. Research or review paper carries 1.0 marks
- 2. Short communications will carry 0.5 marks
